1. The beluga whale is found in the ARCTIC and sub-arctic regions of the world, including Russia, Alaska, Canada, Norway, Greenland and other northern European countries.
2. The beluga whale is a mammal and needs to come to the surface of the water to breathe air through its BLOWHOLE.
3. The beluga whale stays warm in the cold arctic water since 40% of their weight is fat, otherwise known as BLUBBER.
4. The beluga whale is often called “the CANARY of the sea” because of the many sounds it can make.
5. A beluga whale is born with hair, nurses its young and breathes air because it is a MAMMAL.
6. A beluga whale’s forehead is called a MELON. It will change shapes as the whale produces sound.
7. Beluga whales travel in large groups known as PODS.
8. Beluga caviar doesn’t come from beluga whales, but from a Russian sturgeon found in the Caspian SEA.
9. Because of the beluga whale’s color, it is often called a WHITE whale, and it blends in perfectly with the snow and ice where it lives.
