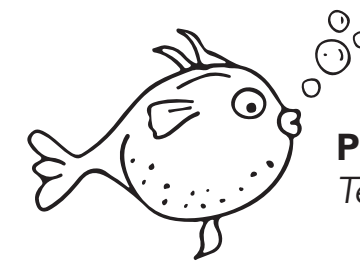
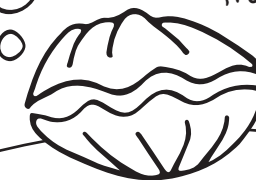


Moorish Idol
Zanclus cornutus

The Moorish idol is a beautiful, peaceful fish that tends to live around coral reefs. It often feeds on coral polyps. Yum!

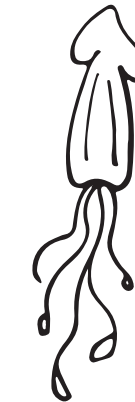
Clam

The giant squid gets its name from its massive size. The largest giant squid ever found was almost 43 feet long and weighed almost 2,000 pounds!

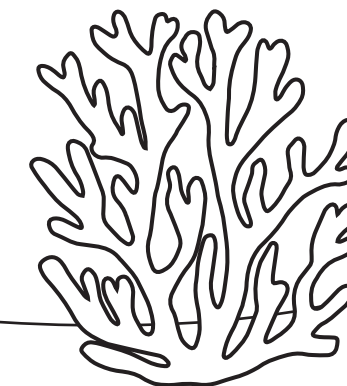


Jelly

Some jellies are clear, some are different colors and others even glow! When animals glow, it is called "bioluminescence."

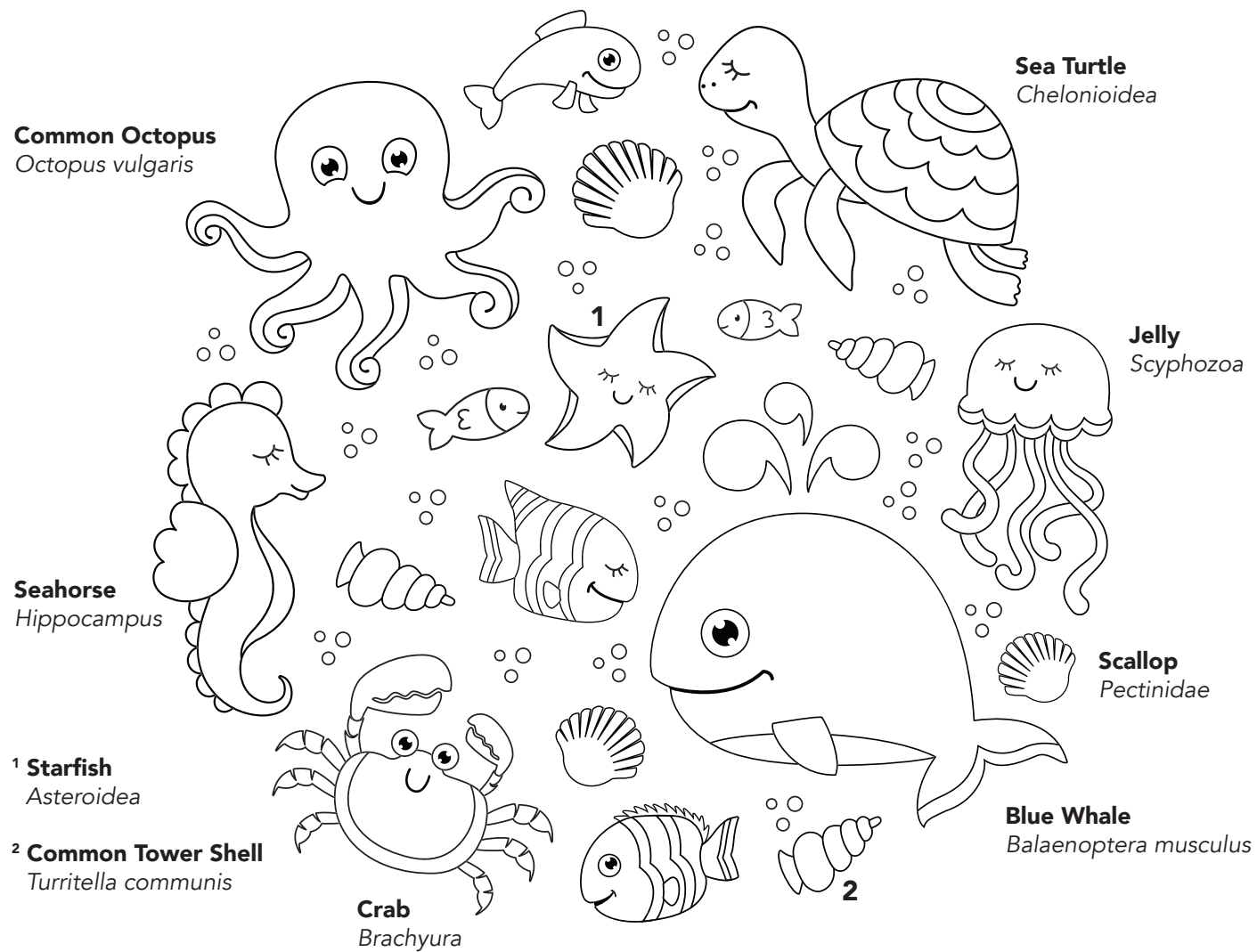
Coral

Before cameras, researchers would have to draw the animals that they saw to keep record of them. Who said you can't mix art and science?

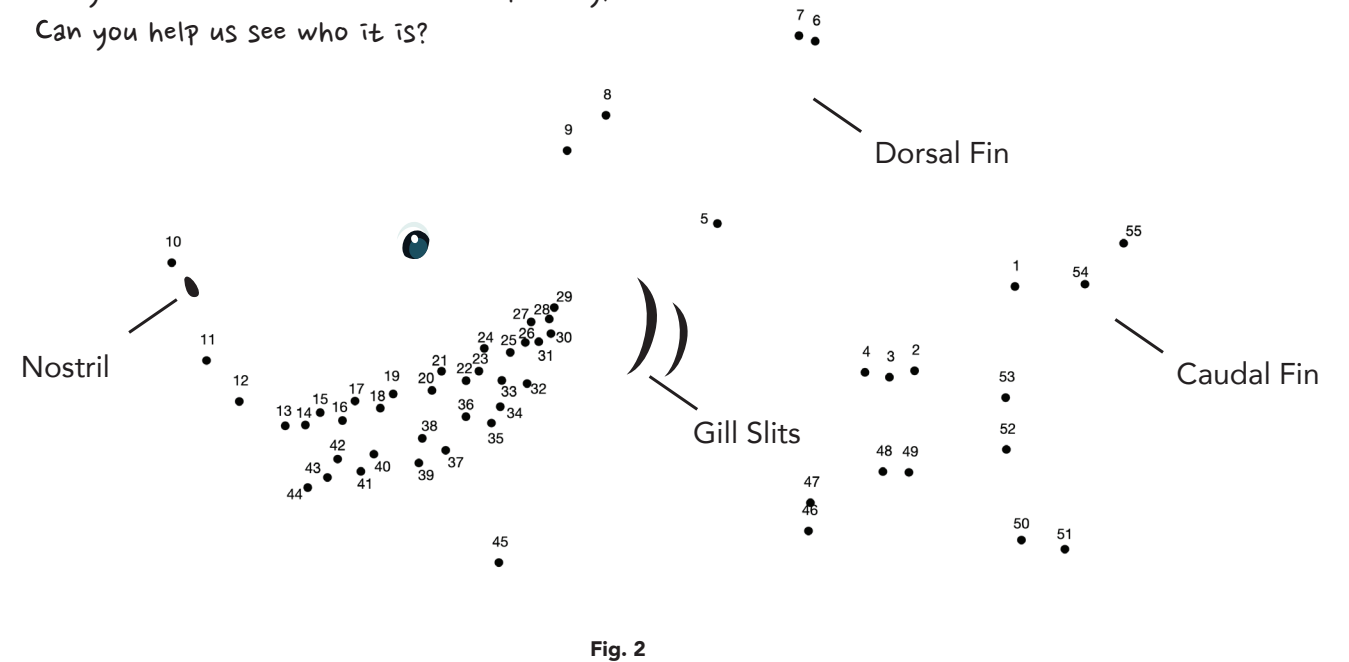

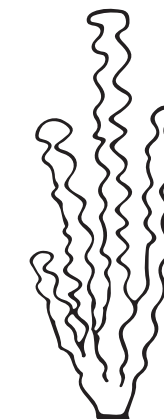
