Cretoxyrhina

Crocodilian Traits: Alligator Allies KEY



<u>Instructions:</u> Label the differences and similarities between the albino alligator and the crocodile.



The mouth: Is in a U shape or rounded

The teeth: Are visible only from the upper jaw if at all, when snout is closed.

The color of a typical alligator is very dark to black with light ventral side.

Similarities between the two: Scutes on back, ectotherms, common ancestor, carnivores, apex predators in their habitats, found in wetland type habitats, camouflage as logs.

The mouth: Is in a V shape or pointed

The teeth: Are visible from both upper and lower jaw, when snout is closed.

The color: Has a light gray color with stripes or spots on the sides and ventral side.
