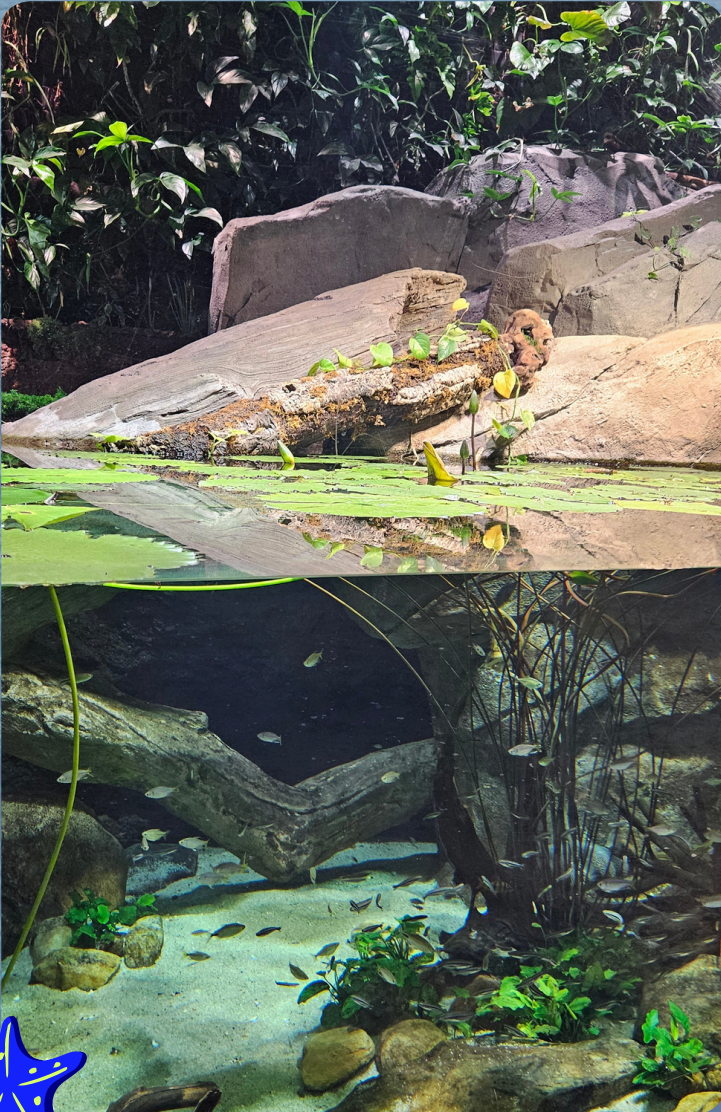


Plant Engineering
